March 30 - Crab corn chowder

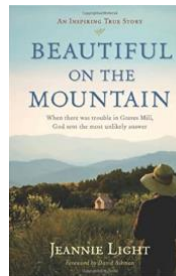
April 6 - Stuffed pepper soup
